- How many students participate in undergraduate research?
- Is there a culminating senior year experience?
- Do you have an honors program or college?
- Do you have a learning community or other freshman experience?

## **Career Match**

- How easy is it to have additional majors and minors?
- When do students have to declare a major?
- What is the process of seeing my college advisor for help with course selection?
